Wingate has always been a pleasant neighborhood for kids to play in, and for people to get out and walk. Lately, however, it seems as though our streets are not as safe as they should be. The posted speed limit is 25mph, but most cars are traveling faster. Our trees and curvy roads make visibility pretty limited and increase the risk of an accident. Homeowners and guests must remember that Wingate is a residential neighborhood, not an arterial.

In addition, our elementary students do not have bus service to Serene Lake Elementary. The crosswalk area behind the school is posted as a school zone, but students are walking and riding their bikes to and from all parts of Wingate. Please be aware of this during the times before school (8:30 AM to 8:55 AM) and after school (2:30-3:00 PM and 3:30-4:00 PM).

By slowing down just a bit, we can all help to make Wingate safer and more enjoyable for everyone.

Should we keep the Fall Meeting going?

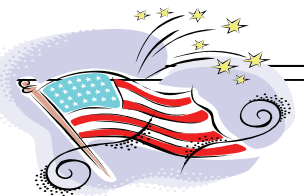
There were only 19 attendees at the homeowner's meeting—a pretty low turnout for a 201 home community.
