Is it Time to Update the Wingate Covenants?

<u>Covenants</u> were prepared for each of the five divisions of Wingate more than 40 years ago. As time goes by and the Covenants grow more out of date, we'd like to start a discussion about getting them consolidated and updated.

Some of our issues with the Covenants as written:

- Instead of one common document for all of Wingate, there are five very similar documents organized by the original construction phases of the neighborhood. All five Covenants are heavily focused on building restrictions because they were written during development of the neighborhood.
- Some conditions of modern life are not well addressed by the Covenants. Home rentals, home businesses, and vehicle parking could all benefit from clarification now.
- Some Covenant restrictions have become outdated. Prohibited conditions such as out-buildings and the keeping of some poultry, both of which are allowed by the County, have become accepted norms in the neighborhood and should be recognized as such in the Covenants.

Your HOA Dues At Work

In 2020, 118 of 201 families paid annual dues to cover landscaping, insurance and other costs to the community. Thanks for your support!

Wingate has a new landscape contractor (Avid Landscape Design and Development) for the front entrances. In addition to regular clean-up and vegetation management of the entrances, your dues have gone towards pruning the cherry tree that was causing the east entrance sign to tilt forward as well as removal of diseased shrubs and trees at the west entrance. Extended pruning was also done at the west entrance to improve eastward visibility for vehicles departing Wingate.
